SCOTTISH DIAMOND angled in and dueled outside a rival, put a head in front on the turn, inched away in the stretch and held under some left handed urging. ACQUIRE THE FIRE chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and gained the place. RUSSIAN LIQUOR stalked the pace between horses then outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and held third. BARODA COURT chased three deep then off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and just missed the show. TO THE PENNY had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CRAIG'S STORM broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and did not rally. SAXOPHONE stumbled badly at the start, settled off the pace inside, continued along the rail throughout and was not a threat.
