COURTLY COUTURE was outrun to the stretch, swung out at the furlong marker and rallied under vigorous handling to gain the win on the wire. CHAMPAGNEANDLILIES stalked on the outside down the backstretch, rallied outside the dueling leaders in the drive and lost the bob at the wire. KAYLIE'S JOY pressed the pace from the outside, moved up on the turn to challenge for the lead, led the way to deep stretch, held on gamely to just miss. HARD EIGHT pulled her way to press the pace from the inside down the backstretch, moved up to take a short lead on the turn and gradually weakened in the stretch drive. FIREY SARA was outrun to the stretch and lacked a sufficient kick in the final furlong. ALLIE WOLFF moved up between horses to take the early lead, was challenged from both sides on the turn and weakened in the stretch drive. ATTA' GIRL was without any early speed on the inside, remained on the wood through the lane and could not make up any ground.

DRINK AT LAST CALL forced the pace outside rival into and around the turn, poked his nose in front entering the lane, continued prolonged battle outside foe and inched away in final yards for very game win. LETS GO INDIAN tucked in behind dueling leaders, stalked on two wide path into the stretch, angled out some in upper stretch, whittled gap on top pair under left hand urging and got up for the place. ZILARATOR dueled then set pressured pace from along the rail, continued battle from the inside through the stretch and only yielded ground grudgingly late then lost second on the wire. DIPLO was off well then taken off the pace, chased two wide, moved up and split foes leaving the turn, moved up some despite lugging out and went willingly to the wire. HARLAN'S TUNE was off bit awkward, settled off the chase, chased outside foe, came three wide into the lane and weakened. SKIMMING SKIPPER gained rail early, stalked from the inside, remained along the fence and also weakened.

PALEO (IRE) unhurried while outside foe then three wide down the hill, came four wide into the stretch, rallied under vigorous handling and nailed inside foe nearing wire. GAMBLING POKERFACE moved up from between rivals, stalked pace from off the rail, loomed four wide leaving the hill, reached the front in midstretch, lugged inward then back out in the drive and was overtaken late. PRETTY KINZIE settled off the pace, chased four wide down the hill and into the lane, came out further, rallied strongly outside and gained the show. FAIR CHASE set pressured pace from along the rail, resisted inside when challenged, fought back some in the drive but weakened late. SKY CHANT angled over, tracked leaders from the inside down the hill, remained along the fence and went evenly to the wire. MISS SEAMLESS bobbled leaving the gate, settled inside then slightly off the rail, between foes later and lacked needed late punch. FAYLEENE was off alertly then taken just off the pace, prompted the issue from off the rail, remained prominent from between foes into the stretch but weakened from between horses in the drive. ROMAN CHARITY settled inside, chased along the rail into the stretch, came off the rail, was blocked behind horses in midstretch and weakened. Rail at 14 feet on the hill.

WARRING HEART settled off the pace, made steady progress three wide into the lane, lugged inward in upper stretch, was straightened then closed gap under left hand urging and collared leader in final jump. BRAYDEN BUDDY broke out but alertly, set pace from outside foe, edged away then padded lead from the inside but drifted out late and was nailed on the wire. HOLLYWOOD MOGUL pressured the pacesetter from the inside, remained along the rail, lost contact around the turn, inside winner into the lane and bested others. WHIZER settled off the pace and off the fence, chased two then three wide into the stretch and went evenly to the wire. MAJOR MADAGAN unhurried from the inside, chased along the rail into and on the bend, swung three wide exiting the turn and was no threat. SPINCO BOB between horses early then gained the rail, continued inside and lacked an effective late response. TURFSUP was slow into stride, crossed over early, chased inside thereafter and was outrun. MAGNIFICENT FORTY reserved while bit off the rail, outside foe early on the turn and weakened.

CAPE TOWN KING angled over then moved up to force the pace, continued outside pacesetter, came in bit entering the lane and chased the winner home. SWISS SKI settled between horses, chased off the rail, came three wide into the lane, lugged out late but kicked clear of others. MY FRIEND LUIS settled off the pace, three wide into the bend, came four wide into the stretch and rallied some from between rivals. WICKED MISCHIEF was off bit slow, came off the fence early, chased four wide around the turn, caught five wide leaving the bend and finished with interest from the far outside. GET OFF THE SUGAR pulled his way up to stalking position along the rail, tracked pace inside, remained along the fence and lost placing late. FIGEAC stalked from off the rail, continued on three wide path into the stretch and weakened. A CAT NAMED SNIPE well placed early from between foes, chased two then three wide into the lane and lacked any late punch. COOPERATION angled over early, remained inside thereafter and failed to reach contention. PROUD HERITAGE settled inside, saved ground to the stretch, drifted out some and weakened.
